

General notes

Distances are in miles.

O & o= big & mini roundabouts, T=T junction, GW=give way, TR & TL mean Turn Right or Left, BR & BL mean Bear Right or Left, SO=Straight On, X=Crossroads, Lts=Lights

DAY 6 – optional ride Cherbourg to Barfleur

	Leave the side of the Mercure hotel, turn right (water on your left)
0.1	Lts stay in right hand land, SO - Sign car ferry
0.4	O 3 rd exit – Rennes
1.0	BL (Rennes) over railway crossing
1.2	O 1 st exit – route Val de Saire
1.6	O 1 st exit Tournelville
1.8	TL Les Flamands
2.6	Lts SO Bretteville
3.3	O 2 nd exit D116 Bretteville
3.8	Enter Le Becquet de Tournelville, stay on D116
4.8	Enter Bretteville, stay on D116 to Fermanville
8.0	Enter Fermanville, stay on D116 – route de vale de Saire
9.1	Stay on D116 Cosqueville
10.8	Enter Cosqueville, stay on D116 to Barfleur
14.3	Enter Neville Sur Mer D116
17.0	Enter Gatteville le Phare, continue on D116 to Barfleur.
18.3	Enter Barfleur, at Stop TL and TL again into the town. Bars and restaurants around the port.

BARFLEUR – CHERBOURG

Return to the Quai at the bottom of the High Street. You can either retrace the route de Val de Saire or:

	Follow Rue Saint Thomas Beckett heading for the water tower
	TR D901 St Pierre-Eglise. Rue de la Halle, stay on D901 bearing left and continue on D901 through...
3.1	Tocqueville
5.7	St Pierre-Eglise – follow 1 way system
6.3	TL D901 Cherbourg
6.4	TL Cherbourg, stay on D901
9.6	Enter Hamel Es Ronches D901 (airport on right)
13.7	O SO D901 Tourlaville, then immediately turn right onto a minor road – if you miss this you will be on a fast dual carriageway.
	Go straight over several sets of Lts onto Rue Gambetta.
16.7	TR (car ferry sign)
16.9	O 2 nd exit car ferries
17.7	O 3 rd exit (embarquement – ferry port). You must be there by 3.30pm
