O & o= big & mini roundabouts, T=T junction, GW=give way, TR & TL mean Turn Right or Left, BR & BL mean Bear Right or Left, SO=Straight On, X=Crossroads, Lts=Lights

Day 5 – Lisieux to Bayeux

	The ride starts opposite the Pharmacie on Rue Henry Cheron, where it finished last night.
0.2	O 2 nd exit, then O 2 nd exit D913
0.4	O 1 st exit D151 uphill Rue de pre d’Auge, stay on D151
2.8	Stay on D151
3.7	Stay on D151 Le pre d’Auge
4.5	Enter Pré d’Auge
4.8	SO stay on D151
5.5	X SO on D151
5.9	Enter Saint-Ouen-le-Pin
6.6	TR at Y shape junction with Water tower. D85a to Rumesnil and Dozule
8.8	X SO to Dozule D85a (narrow road)
10.4	T TR on to D85 Dozule
10.9	X SO stay on D85
11.1	Enter Rumesnil TL onto D117 to Le Ham
14.6	T TR onto D49 Beuvron on Auge
14.8	TL D117 to Le Ham & Troarn
15.7	T TR D78 Le Ham & Troarn, stay on D78
17.8	Enter Le Ham
19.2	Stay on D78
19.5	Enter St Pierre du Jonquet, 20.5 Enter Janville
22.1	SO through Troarn
22.5	STOP, SO Le Royal Bar/tabac on left mandatory check in – Boulangerie etc.

	Continue on D78 becomes D95 to Varaville
25.2	TL D236 to Bavent – small road.

35.0	TR on to D514. Boulevard Aristide Bernard
	We stay on the D514 coast road all the way through, Luc-Sur Mer, Lagrune sur Mer, St. Aubin-Sur-Mer, Bernières sur Mer, Courseulles-Sur-Mer, Ver sur Mer, Asnelles. The coast is on your right.
51.8	Enter La Guerre: You have the choice here to go straight to Bayeux or via Arromanches (big hill, Museum, great views etc) There is very little difference in the mileage.
	Option 1 - Via Arromanches continue on D154 uphill to Arromanches, then continue on D154 to Bayeux.
